

Image Resizing on resize2mail.com website

Directions for resizing images on <http://www.resize2mail.com/>

Resize your digital photo images in three easy steps!

1. Select the image you would like to resize with [Browse...]
2. Select the size you would like your new image to be
 - a. Be sure to resize your images according to the Website Style Guide (See dimension below)
3. Click the okay button and wait for the next page to show up
4. Save the resized image.

Second Level Landing Page Main Image Template

Description: This is for the image that will show up on the main second-level pages (Admissions, Academics, About, etc.) Dimensions (pixels): 622 X 185

Faculty/ Staff Image Template

Description: This is for the image that will show up next to a faculty/staff information (Academic, Curriculum, Majors and Minors, Faculty) Dimensions (pixels): 56 x 72
